
USE YOUR VOICE

- ✓ **Use intonation** in your voice to maintain students' attention.
- ✓ **“That’s not all...”**, really sell it to your audience. Create the occasional ‘cliff hanger’ in your sentences.
- x monotone monologues can seem dull and boring no matter how interesting the subject is.



MIX IT UP



- ✓ **Flip the classroom;** find out what your students know and what perspectives they can give you.
- ✓ **Create a dialogue;** Ask students a question or their opinion about the material discussed.
- ✓ **Share yourself;** Students will feel more engaged with you if they know something about you. Where possible try and make examples personal.

IN PRACTICE

- ✓ **Know your technology;** Knowing how the software works that you use will give you one less thing to contend with.
 - x Getting to know your software during a lecture will give your audience the wrong impression and waste precious time.
- ✓ **Know your audience;** Try things out and see what works for you. Ask for feedback and suggestions from your audience.
 - x If one of the listed tips does not work for you, do not force it. Everyone creates their own unique teaching style over time.
